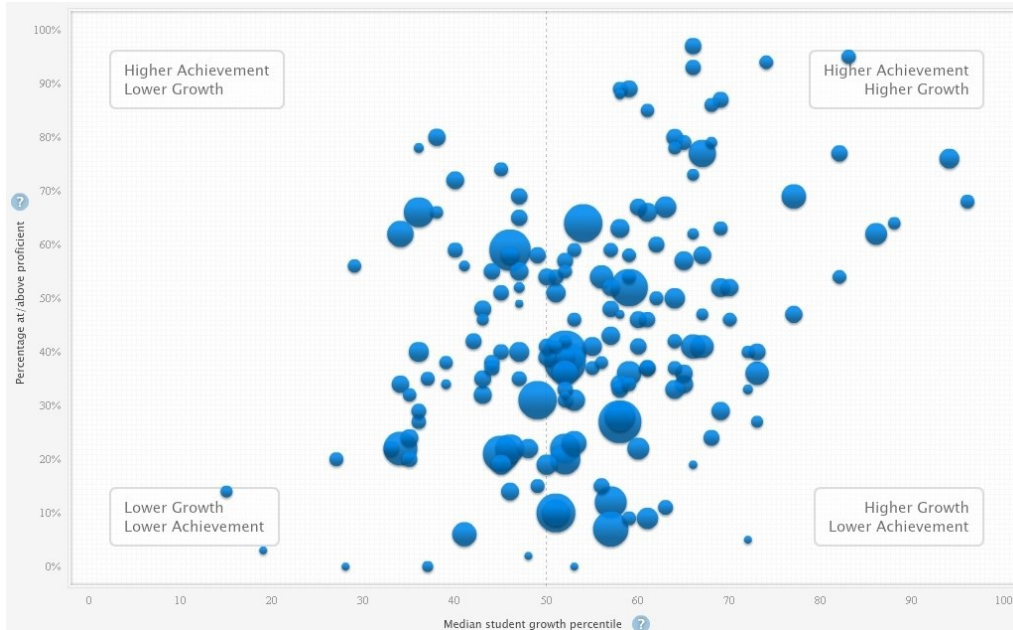


Interpreting and Using Data from the Growth Model

Understanding state accountability ratings, and using growth data in improvement planning and educator and principal evaluation.

As other states have implemented the Colorado Growth Model, CTLT has provided similar support in other states.

- Explain school and group-level growth metrics.
- Read and interpret school-level and group-level Growth Model views/reports.
- Use growth data to identify trends in performance over time (at least 3 years).
- Set annual growth performance targets.
